Even if you say something because you're angry or you think it's funny, your comment could be perceived as a threat.

What does this mean?

If you threaten to harm others:

- You could be asked to leave the dialysis clinic.
- Law enforcement could be called.
- You could be involuntary discharged from the dialysis clinic.

Many patients who have been involuntarily discharged have a difficult time finding a new dialysis facility.

If you are angry, stay calm and talk to your clinic manager or social worker. You can also call the ESRD Network at 800.826.3773.
