### **General MIPS Questions for Your Vendor**

- What level of support is available for MIPS reporting?
- Does anything have to be outsourced for MIPS reporting?
- Can you provide clinical quality data/PI data in the CMS-acceptable format, so we can submit for MIPS?
- Are there electronic clinical quality measures (eCQMs) available?
- Is a MIPS Dashboard built in? Can the user access it?
- Is the data from the MIPS Dashboard in real-time? If not, when does it update (nightly, once a week, etc.)?
- Do you have materials or training for users that includes how to optimize your software for MIPS?
- Can the EHR be used to report MIPS measures and activities directly to CMS? If so, what is the cost?
- Can a third party access the data if the EHR cannot be used to report MIPS measures and activities directly to CMS? If so, what is the cost?
- Are there peer practices that we can share strategies with, or a user's group, dedicated to MIPS?

## **PI Questions for Your Vendor**

Are there tutorials or videos for measure documentation?

#### e-Prescribing Objective

- When reporting the required e-Prescribing measure, does the EHR report an exclusion automatically if the denominator is less than 100, or do I have a choice to either take an exclusion or report the data?
- Is the PDMP built into the EHR?
  - o If yes, will the EHR report this optional measure?
  - o Is there an additional cost to add this model or interface to the EHR?
- If the EHR does not have the PDMP as a module, can I document in the EHR when the PDMP was queried while caring for the patient? Will the EHR then submit this optional measure for bonus points?

## PI Questions for Your Vendor

#### HIE Objective (Three measures, two options)

- Is the EHR capable of sending health information (the Summary of Care) to other providers and facilities in the appropriate format?
- What is the clinician's direct address as provided by the EHR?
- Is the EHR capable of receiving and incorporating health information from other providers and facilities?
  - o Does the EHR collect both the numerator and denominator for these measures?
- Is the EHR capable of interfacing and engaging in bi-directional exchange with an HIE?
  - o What is the cost for this interface?
- Does the EHR document the receipt of the Summary of Care by the other party?
- Does the EHR automatically report an exclusion if the denominator is less than 100?
  - o Do I have a choice to take an exclusion or report the data?

#### **Public Health and Clinical Data Exchange Objective**

- Which state and national public health registries and data exchanges is the EHR able to connect with?
  - o Can data be both sent and received?
  - o Do you assist with connecting to these public health registries?
  - o Is there an additional cost to connect to these public health registries?
- How does the EHR report this measure to CMS?
  - o Do I need to do anything to report this measure?
  - o How does the EHR report exclusions for this measure?
- Is the FHR able to attest to one connection and take an exclusion for the other?

#### **Provide Patients Access to Their EHR (Patient portal)**

- Can you confirm the EHR correctly calculates this measure by including in the numerator all unique patients who have been offered access to the patient portal?
- Is there a cost for patient portal?

#### Security Risk Analysis (SRA)

- What are the criteria for the EHR to report this measure? (https://www.healthit.gov/topic/privacy-security-andhipaa/security-risk-assessment-tool)
- Do I have to manually enter confirmation that the SRA has been completed or reviewed?

#### Safety Assurance Factors for EHR Resilience (SAFER) Guides

- What are the criteria for the EHR to report this measure?
- Do I have to manually enter confirmation that the SAFER Guides have been completed or reviewed?

#### PI Exceptions

As of 2022, small practices will be automatically granted a PI hardship exception, but submitting any PI data negates the exception. How should I inform the EHR that I will choose to take the automatic PI hardship exception?
