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# Tobacco Use-Related Quality Measures

Tobacco Use: Screening and Cessation Intervention	Tobacco Use and Help with Quitting Among Adolescents
<p>Percentage of patients aged 18 and older who were screened for tobacco use one or more times within 24 months AND who received cessation counseling intervention if identified as a tobacco user</p>	<p>Percentage of adolescents 12 to 20 years of age with a primary care visit during the measurement year for whom tobacco use status was documented and received help with quitting if identified as a tobacco user</p>

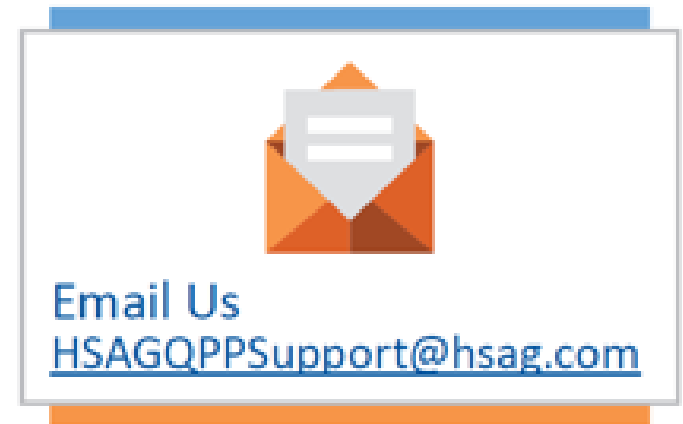
# Tobacco Use-Related Improvement Activities

Tobacco Use	Use of Certified EHR To Capture Patient Reported Outcomes
<p>Tobacco use: Regular engagement of MIPS-eligible clinicians or groups in integrated prevention and treatment interventions, including tobacco use screening and cessation interventions (refer to NQF #0028) for patients with co-occurring conditions of behavioral or mental health and at risk factors for tobacco dependence.</p>	<p>In support of improving patient access, performing additional activities that enable capture of patient reported outcomes (e.g., home blood pressure, blood glucose logs, food diaries, at-risk health factors such as tobacco or alcohol use, etc.) or patient activation measures through use of certified EHR technology, containing this data in a separate queue for clinician recognition and review.</p>
