What does this mean?

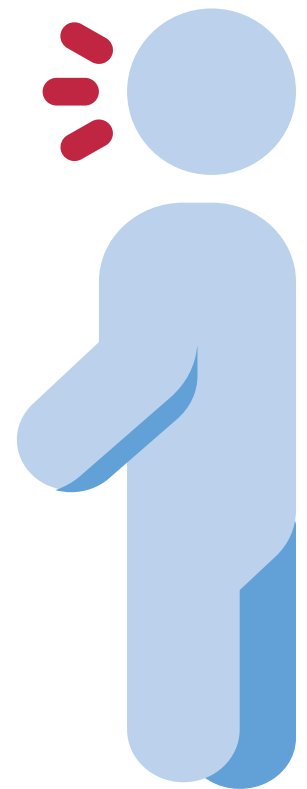
If you threaten to harm others:

- You could be asked to leave the dialysis clinic.
- Law enforcement could be called.
- You could be involuntarily discharged from the dialysis clinic.

Many patients who have been involuntarily discharged have a difficult time finding a new dialysis facility.
