

Could Transplant Be Right for You?

In the past, you mentioned that you did not want to have a kidney transplant. We feel it is important to revisit all the care options available to you, including transplant, at least once a year. If you still do not want a transplant, it would be helpful for us to know why so we can ensure you have the support and information you need regarding modality options.

Additionally, the information you provide will be combined with feedback from other patients and sent to your ESRD Network. The Network will keep your responses confidential but will use them to develop new educational materials regarding transplant as a modality option.
